BS+MS in Entomology Timeline

What to expect

The Department of Entomology has a new degree program that allows students to obtain both a BS and MS degrees through an integrated 5-year plan of study. This program prepares students for careers that require knowledge of entomology and for pursuing subsequent medical or doctoral degrees.



SOPHOMORE (2ND YR)

You will want to be reading up on the program requirements and identifying potential major professors conducting research that interests you.



SENIOR (4TH YR)

Start your thesis research (if have not already), and complete the requirements for the BS in Entomology, Apply for MS at end of senior vr. Graduate with BS in Entomology.

(FRESHMAN (1ST YR)

Incoming freshman wih HS GPA > 3.5 and a declared Entomology Major may be provisionally accepted into the BS+MS program. Continuation in the program is contingent on meeting program requirements and officailly applying at the end of vour iunior vear.



JUNIOR (3RD YR)

Attend an informational session and/or meet with the BS+MS faculty advisor (Dr. Erin Rankin). Make sure you meet the eligibility requirements of the program. You will need to discuss research plans with your major professor. Submit the Statement of Eligibility and Interest (SIE) by the end of your 3rd year.



MS (5TH YR)

Complete requirements for MS including finishing your thesis research, writing up your thesis and defending the MS by end of MS year. Graduate with MS in Entomology.
