## University of California Riverside's Entomology's Junior Entomologists Summer Camp COVID-19 Health Screening

We all have a responsibility to help reduce the spread of COVID-19 and keep ourselves and others safe. This document was developed in alignment with the guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and state and local health authorities. **This document serves as a guide and will be updated.** 

# **COVID-19 Vaccinations:**

While staying up to date with COVID-19 vaccines is strongly encouraged, it is not required. The decision of whether to be vaccinated and/or which vaccine to receive is one you should make in consultation with your medical provider after reviewing all available information.

# **Testing:**

Camp counselors and campers should test for COVID-19 within 72 hours of the start of the camp. Appointments for PCR testing are available free of charge through curative.com. If you are using an at-home kit, you need to test twice 5 days apart to try and avoid false negatives. Follow the isolation protocols if you test positive.

## Mask/Face Covering:

Face coverings are not required but are recommended indoors for those who are up to date on vaccinations, which includes receiving recommended COVID-19 vaccines. Face coverings indoors will remain required for anyone who is not up to date on vaccinations. This aligns with the recommendations of UCR's Public Health Advisory Group. Anyone who needs an accommodation to comply with the mask/face covering requirement should contact scast032@ucr.edu.

## **Continuing COVID-19 Protocols:**

Any camp counselor or camper who experiences COVID-19 symptoms or tests positive for COVID-19 should not attend the camp, regardless of their vaccination status, and should seek treatment and/or advice from an appropriate healthcare provider.
